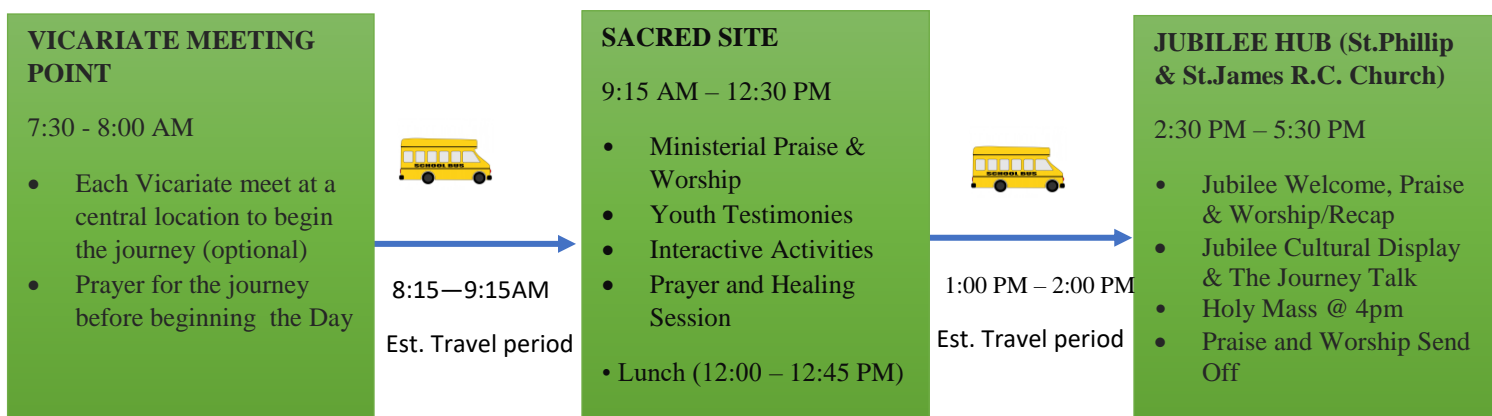


## Sacred Site Guide

**Theme:** *“The Journey Starts Here: Called by Christ, Moved by Hope”*

 **Date:** Saturday, 9th August 2025

Each Vicariate will journey to a specified sacred site with the day ending at our Jubilee Hub! The sacred site assigned per Vicariate were chosen to give the youth a change outside their Vicariate to emphasize the idea of pilgrimage, leaving what’s familiar to encounter God in a new way! We are estimated 150 -200 pilgrims per sacred site. The ages are between 11- 35, pilgrims will be accompanied by their youth leaders/ catechists or parents on this journey. These pilgrim leaders will be marked using a “Pilgrim Leader” tag for ease of communication and coordination.

## **Sacred Site Experience (9:15 AM – 12:30 PM)**

### **Sacred Site Committee Tasks:**

- Organize **audio system, microphones, and seating**
- The Sacred Site committee together with parishes within its vicariate are asked to source a praise and worship team/choir within their vicariate.

### **Break Time (10:15 – 10:30 AM)**

### **📖 Reflection & Prayer Ministry (10:30 AM – 12:00 PM)**

- Guided Reflection- Done by the prayer group
- Prayer & Healing session - Done by the prayer group
- Altar Call for Testimonies

- Assist prayer group – provide Holy water & anointing oil
- Reconciliation areas – designate reconciliation areas

### **Lunch Break (12:00 – 12:45 PM)**

- Youth bring own lunch
- Sacred site Committees ensure seating space (lawn, shaded areas, benches, tables)
- Pilgrims leave Sacred Site by 1:00 PM for the Jubilee Hub.

# Sacred Site Committee Responsibilities

- Hospitality Welcome and Seating for pilgrims.
- Support prayer group by providing the Holy Water, Anointing oil and Blessed Sacrament Exposition on the altar during their session
- Coordinate Choir Teams for Praise & Worship
- Organize Audio & Tech Setup
- Arrange Reconciliation Areas
- Facilitate Youth Passport Stamping
- Setup Lunch Areas (lawn, shaded spots, benches, tables)
- Please have a dedicated prayer group praying for the youth on this journey during the day

Please note that we have formed vicariate subcommittees which is made up of the youth leaders within each vicariate who will be responsible for assisting with the itinerary for the and also to ensure that you all have the support needed on the day.
